The Family Life Center has everything you need to begin your journey into a life of regular exercise. The FLC has an updated cardio room including 5 treadmills, 2 elliptical machines, 4 stationary bikes, 2

recumbent bikes, 2 rowing machines, and 1 SkiErg machine. An *indoor track* is available to help you reach your steps goal when winter weather prevents you from walking outside. An expansive *weight room*, including both pin-select machines and free weights, will meet all of your strength training needs. The FLC also has a *full gymnasium* and a *large game room*, complete with pool tables, ping-pong tables, air hockey, and foosball tables. Family Life Center memberships may be purchased at any time and renew each January.
