
Dear Church Family,

"We should not artificially turn away from our [worries] by constantly [losing ourselves in social media] or running to the movies, or some other kind of busywork, but rather direct our cares to him who wills to bear and share all our sin and all our suffering and, therefore, all our cares. WEEK OF PRAYER FOR NORTH AMERICAN MISSIONS March 2-9


